- Tour may be canceled or adjusted due to weather/unforeseen events.
- Use a waterproof bag for valuables.
- Starting from Ubud is most convenient; from Nusa Dua/Jimbaran/Uluwatu, tour is ~2 hours longer.

- Option available without tickets for flexibility.
